There are 3 airports that service the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Due to its convenience with Metrorail & location, we highly recommend National (DCA). Please visit the airport websites listed for additional information on ground transportation. Listed in order of convenience:

• **Ronald Reagan National Airport (DCA):** Located south of the city along the Potomac River. Taxi fare to the hotel is approximately \$18. Also accessible on Metrorail's Yellow & Blue Lines

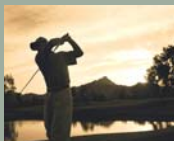
