- **Taxi:** Many companies provide taxicab service at the San Diego International Airport. If you need a taxi, simply follow the signs leading to the Transportation Plazas. A Transportation Coordinator will place you with the first available taxi – unless you specify a particular taxicab company. ESTIMATED TAXICAB FARE FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE HOTEL DEL CORONADO: \$30.00

- **Private Transportation:** For a complete list of limousine/luxury sedan providers, please refer to the San Diego Yellow Pages or local San Diego Convention & Visitors Bureau website at www.sandiego.org/nav/Visitors/GettingAround/LimousinesandTownCars - Be sure to verify with your limousine/luxury sedan provider that the company is licensed to pick up passengers at the San Diego International Airport.

- **Rental Car:** Car rental reservation boards are located near the baggage claim areas of Terminals 1 and 2. Use the courtesy phones provided to request shuttle transport to the car rental company of your choice. If you follow the signage to any of these areas, it is likely that a shuttle will be waiting.
